Dear Parents:

The Glendora Unified School District operates a before and after school program at each elementary and middle school. The purpose of this letter is to offer parents an opportunity to enroll their children in the EDC Program for the 2022-2023 school year.

The program is supported by the parents of children who participate. The cost, which is subject to change, is \$25 per day for the first child and \$24 per day for each additional child from the same family. Due to the Los Angeles County Department of Public Health guidelines and requirements still in place, we will only be enrolling for the limited capacity and space available at each site. Once a site is full, a waitlist will be established. We thank you for your patience. As guidelines change or if they are lifted more children will be enrolled. During this time, we are not offering a three-day or four-day option. All families will be billed monthly based on the daily rate that has been adjusted during this time.

The centers are open from 7 a.m. – 8 a.m. and after school until 6:00 p.m. each day that school is in session. The goal of the Extended Day-Care Program is to present enriching experiences which complement regular classroom activities and enhance the cognitive, physical, emotional and social development of each participant in a safe and supportive learning environment. Homework assistance is also provided.

Applications should be brought in to the Child Development Office, along with a **\$120 non-refundable deposit** for each student being enrolled. The deposit includes a \$30 registration fee. The remaining \$90 will be credited to the first month of school. If you are registering after the school year begins, the month's tuition plus \$30.00 registration will be payable at the time of registration.

Registration opens March 1, 2022 at 7:00 a.m. We will not take any applications before March 1. Please be aware that sites tend to reach maximum capacity level so it is best to come in on that date.

Applications from families with outstanding balances cannot be processed until the account is paid in full.
